- **Extemporaneous Writing**- does not include an online proctored round 1 test. However, students will follow the same procedure as those taking an online proctored test. The secret topic will be given to students when the proctor signs them into the system and then they have 1 hour to write about that topic.

- **Health Career Display**- does not include an online proctored round 1 test. However, students need to set up an account in Tallo and upload documents described in guidelines as Round 1 (health display board pictures) and Round 2 (video of their presentation of health display board) in the [HCD Guidelines](#).
  - Round 1 pictures (up to 8) to upload in Tallo (per guidelines)- Job responsibilities; education requirements; entry level salary at the local/national/global level;

benefits/challenges associated with career; additional relevant information. Follow all rules in guidelines- including reference pages. Should all be uploaded as one combined pdf file.

- Round 2 Presentation to upload in Tallo (everyone advances to Round two at SLC)- upload a 5 minute prepared oral presentation per guidelines (both team members must take an active role in the presentation).
  - Uploads for SLC are open in Tallo and must be complete by Wednesday March 22. Instructions for uploading materials to Tallo can be found [HERE](#). Once you create an account in Tallo go to FIND OPPORTUNITIES and type in Vermont HOSA to find your event. Only 1 person for team events needs to submit in Tallo for the whole team.

  - Bring Display to SLC at Castleton to show off all your hard work!
- **Health Career Photography-** does not include an online proctored round 1 test. However, students need to set up an account in Tallo and upload documents and video's of their presentations. Round 1 & 2 described in guidelines are combined. The ENTIRE completed portfolio (including photos, narratives, & permission forms) must be uploaded as a single document, pdf preferred, by competitor. Also, upload a video of the competitor presenting their photographs as described in guidelines (must follow time rules) to Tallo:
    - 1 document including: 3 photos of different health professionals: title page for each photo, narrative for each photo, and permission forms for each
    - Upload video: The competitor will have a maximum of three (3) minutes (approximately one minute per photo) to present the picture, describe the profession, explain what is happening in the picture and how the career fits into the healthcare system. Competitors may hold their portfolio/photos as they present them.
    - Uploads for SLC are open in Tallo and must be complete by Wednesday March 22. Instructions for uploading materials to Tallo can be found [HERE](#). Once you create an account in Tallo go to FIND OPPORTUNITIES and type in Vermont HOSA to find your event.

- **Mental Health Promotion-** does not include an online proctored round 1 test. However, students need to set up an account in Tallo and upload documents described in guidelines as Round 1 (PDF upload) and Round 2 (presentation) in the guidelines.
    - The below materials should be uploaded as one combined PDF file:
      - All members must complete the [Be There Certificate](#) online course and upload each member's certificate to Tallo.
      - Upload all digital files showing the Social Media Campaign-including any images, graphics, and links to videos and/or posts. For links, type or copy/paste the URL link into the pdf file and ensure all links are set to PUBLIC permissions so judges can view them.
      - Completed Mental Health Consultant Form, page 6 of guidelines.
      - Reference Pages(s).
    - Presentation must be uploaded to Tallo and teams have a maximum of seven (7) minutes to present their campaign. Per guidelines the presentation will:

- a. Share key points that the team learned from taking the Be There Certification.
- b. Explain the risk and/or protective factors the social media campaign addressed.
- c. Summarize “why” the selected topic was chosen (the needs assessment/evaluation of the school/community, and/or the interest by the team).
- d. Outline the timeline and methods used in the campaign.
- e. Share how the Mental Health Consultant was utilized in the learning process.
- f. Describe potential next steps and how the team could implement additional projects and further make a difference regarding the identified target topic.

#### SKILLS EVENTS:

- **CPR & First Aid/EMT/NA-** Students complete Round 1 online proctored testing at their school on Monday March 20th. Round 2 will be completed in Tallo. Students need to set up accounts in Tallo and upload a video of them and their partner (for team events) completing the secret skill(s) that will be released via email to their advisor on Monday March 20th. It is imperative that members DO NOT share which skills are chosen until after SLC is complete. Sharing of the skills that are used at SLC can result in disqualification.
  - Uploads for SLC are open in Tallo and must be complete by Wednesday March 22. Instructions for uploading materials to Tallo can be found [HERE](#).
